Non-current issues of magazines may be borrowed for three weeks.

If any item is lost or damaged so as to render it substantially unusable, the patron shall be assessed replacement and processing costs.

Patrons who have accumulated unpaid late fees or who have not paid to replace a lost or damaged book will have their borrowing privileges suspended. Borrowing privileges will be restored once the accumulated charges have been reduced to less than the maximum fee amount.

Late Fees:

Patrons have a 3-day grace period after the due date to return items without accruing late fees. However, on the fourth late day, fees are charged daily beginning with the date due. *Fines are not charged on days the library is closed.
